Title: Aunt Eater Solves a Mystery

Characters?

Aunt Eater Mr. Chumly Sam

Setting?

Aunt Eater's house Outside Alley

Problem

- A. Mr. Chumly's cat, Sam, disappears when Aunt Eater is taking care of him.
- B. Sam disappears when the lights go out at Aunt Eater's house.

Solution

Aunt Eater finds Sam in an alley.

Events

- 1. Aunt Eater looks around the house.
- 2. Aunt Eater goes outside to look for clues.
- Aunt Eater sees paw prints and follows them to an alley.
- 4. Aunt Eater finds hundreds of cats in the alley, and they all look like Sam.
- 5. Aunt Eater offers fish to the cats because she knows that Sam doesn't like fish.
- 6. Aunt Eater figures out which cat is Sam because he is the only one who doesn't come for fish.

Notes:

• It is important to mention, either in the problem or introductory sentence, that Aunt Eater is taking care of Sam. Otherwise the reader wouldn't know **why** it is a problem that Sam disappears.
